THURSDAY, MAY 9 | NOON | BUILDING 2 ROOM A

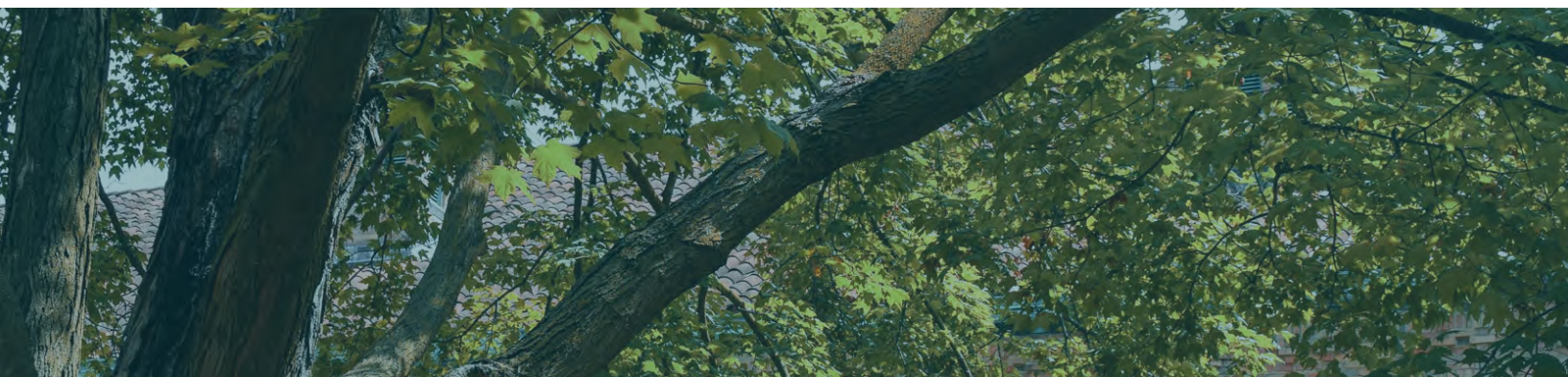
Jubilee Ladies will be serving breakfast for lunch in their next gathering and then finish fleece blankets for New Mercies Ministries. Please register if you are able to come.

Summer book study will meet on Thursday nights, at 7 pm, June 20th, July 11th, and August 1st in the chapel!

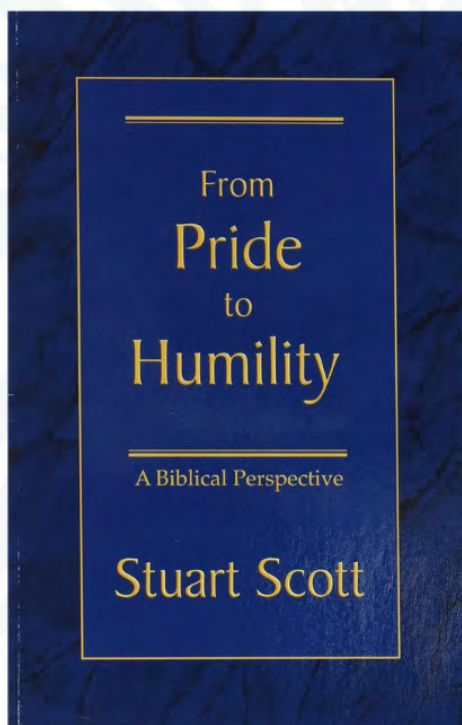
OUR STUDY: From Pride to Humility- a biblical perspective

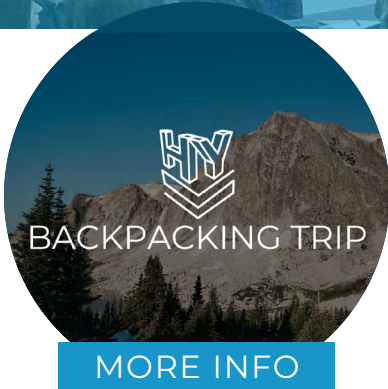
Step 1 | Sign up online and choose to be a part of a Summer Table Group or sign up to read the book on your own by June 9th.
