Summer book study will meet on Thursday nights, at 7 pm, June 20th, July 11th, and August 1st in the chapel!


#### OUR STUDY: From Pride to Humility- a biblical perspective

"Pride is your greatest enemy; humility is your greatest friend."—John R.W. Stott Pride is at the heart of every sin a man commits—and pleasing God can be narrowed down to one word: humility. In our Summer Book Study, we will look at biblical insights into identifying and overcoming pride in our lives and learn how to move from pride to humility. Humility doesn't come naturally to us, so as men of God we have to be intentional about moving from pride to humility. Our study includes examples, diagrams and questions that will help us turn from pride and become more and more like Christ.




#### ARTSCAMP JUNE 17-21 | HEADWATERS CHURCH
